
Auriculotherapy

Written in a concise style the book covers the basic essentials of auriculotherapy: the anatomy and geometry of the ear, representation of the organs in the ear, point detection and treatment, the three phases and the Nogier frequencies. In addition, 25 indications for auriculotherapy are discussed, among them sciatica, food allergies, fertility disorders and depressive disorders. Over 60 illustrations support the didactic concept of the book.

In the light of contemporary neuroscience, the information in this book expands and updates previously published works in English by the author's father, Dr Paul Nogier. He is widely credited with introducing the practical application of ear acupuncture in Europe. Dr Raphael Nogier is the best-qualified auriculotherapists to pass on the concepts which will improve the skill of the acupuncture practitioner. A serviceable, contemporary work for students of acupuncture as well as practitioners, offering clear and practical information to be applied directly for the benefit of patients.
