

Herbs are discrete botanical entities; their phytochemical constituents both characterise their botanical type and provide the medium for pharmacological effect.



Although this book acknowledges that herbs are pharmacologically active because of their phytochemical constituents, it does not argue for the subsuming of Chinese herbal medicine into biomedicine. Rather, it views both the Chinese medical and biomedical models as having their own strengths, believing there to be potential for collaborative benefit in respect both of acquiring medical benefits and avoiding iatrogenicity.
